## Cost

Total student cost\*1: \$2,000

- A non-refundable\*2 15% deposit (\$300) is due by April 1st, 2024 to reserve a spot.
- A total of 50% (\$1,000) is due by June 1<sup>st</sup> (non-refundable after October 1<sup>st</sup>).
- 100% (\$2,000) due by October 1<sup>st</sup>\*5.

Total guest (i.e., parents/siblings\*3,4) cost\*1: \$1,500

- A non-refundable\*<sup>2</sup> 15% deposit (\$225) is due by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.
- 50% (\$750) due by June 1<sup>st</sup> (non-refundable after October 1<sup>st</sup>).
- 100% (\$1,500) due by October 1<sup>st</sup>.\*5

\*5 Individuals who must cancel their attendance between June 1st\_October 1st will be refunded their 2nd deposit (i.e., \$700/student; \$525/guest). Cancellation after October 1st will result in a refund of the 3rd deposit (i.e., \$1000/student; \$750/guest).

## How to Pay:

## Tentative Schedule

- Before September—Students acquire a copy of *Flooded* [store.apologeticspress.org/products/flooded]
- September 1<sup>st</sup>—Students begin reading *Flooded* and taking quizzes on the FloodedQuizzes.org site. [All quizzes should be completed before October 29<sup>th</sup>.] **Parents are advised to book flights for their student(s) by this point.**
- October 29<sup>th</sup>—Those flying should arrive at the Phoenix Airport in time to catch the course buses. [Bus departure time to be announced in the coming weeks.]
- October 29<sup>th</sup>–9<sup>th</sup>—Course ensues. Besides the quizzes which should be completed prior to the onsite portion of
  the course, the course will include lecture, laboratories, an exam, videos, a final paper, and fieldtrips to Grand
  Canyon, Grand Canyon Caverns, S&P Crater, Meteor Crater, Petrified Forest/Painted Desert, Museum of Northern
  Arizona, Out of Africa Wildlife Park, Lowell Observatory, and Lava River Cave.
- November 9<sup>th</sup>—Leave the housing facilities. The course bus will drive to the airport those students who are flying.
  [Ensure that the departure flight is after the bus arrival time. Bus schedule to be announced in the coming weeks.]

<sup>\*1</sup> Cost covers all expenses after arrival in Flagstaff, AZ October 29<sup>th</sup>, including food, housing, tickets, bus, staff/instruction, miscellaneous expenses, and (for the students) supplies.

<sup>\*2</sup> The deposit will be returned if the course is cancelled due to insufficient registrations or if available slots are filled.

<sup>\*3</sup> All individuals onsite who will be at least 18 by October 29th must pay the instructor to have a background check conducted on them.

<sup>\*4</sup> Students will be given preference regarding space. There will be a limited number of beds in the dorms and seats on the bus. In the event that all beds/seats are filled by students/staff, guests will receive a refund of \$300 to go towards arranging their own housing/transportation in Flagstaff.
