

2026 *Flooded* (Foundations of Science) High School Course [Fall Session]

Initial Registration & Information

Cost

Total **student** cost*¹: \$2,300

[Students must be **ages 14-18** on October 27th*³.]

- A partially refundable*² 50% deposit (\$1,150) must be **received** by **May 1st, 2026** to reserve a spot. [**Initial registration deadline extended to August 26.**]
- The final deposit (\$1,150) must be **received** by **October 1st***⁴.

Total **guest** (i.e., parents/siblings*^{3,5}) cost: \$1,800

- A partially refundable*² 50% deposit (\$900) must be **received** by **May 1st, 2026** to reserve a spot. [**Initial registration deadline extended to August 26.**]
- The final deposit (\$900) must be **received** by **October 1st***⁴.

*¹ Cost covers all expenses after arrival in Flagstaff, AZ October 27th, including food, housing, tickets, bus, staff/instruction, miscellaneous expenses, and (for the students) supplies.

*² The full initial deposit will be returned (minus any electronic processing fees) **if the course is cancelled** due to insufficient registrations or if available slots are filled. If the course is **not cancelled** and a student withdraws from the course before October 1st, **half** of his/her initial deposit will be refunded (minus any electronic processing fee).

*³ All individuals onsite who will be at least 18 by October 27th must pay the instructor to have a background check conducted on them.

*⁴ Withdrawing from the course between October 1st and 27th will result in a refund of the 2nd deposit only (minus e-fees).

*⁵ Students will be given preference regarding space. There will be a limited number of seats on the buses. In the event that all seats are filled by students/staff, guests will need to arrange their own rental car (e.g., coordinating with other guests).

How to Pay:

- Checks can be made out to **Apologetics Press**. Checks should be mailed in time to **reach AP by the due dates**. It is advised that you email Dr. Miller (Jeff@apologeticspress.org) if you sent a check via mail. *****NOTE: It is important that the "For" line of the check be labeled "Flooded Course Fall" followed by the student's name. - To pay electronically, go to FloodedBook.org/FallFloodedCourse/ and click the appropriate link to pay through the AP webstore. *****NOTE: an electronic processing fee will be added to your payment amount.**

Tentative Schedule [***Dual enrollment student schedule slightly different.]

- Before September—Students acquire a copy of *Flooded* (second edition) [store.apologeticspress.org/products/flooded]
- September 1st—Students begin reading *Flooded* and taking quizzes on the FloodedQuizzes.org site. [The book should be finished and all quizzes completed **before October 27th**.] **Parents are advised to book flights for their student(s) by this point.**
- October 27th—Those flying should arrive at the Phoenix Airport in time to catch the course buses. [Bus departure time to be announced in the coming weeks.]
- October 27th-November 8th—Course ensues. Besides the quizzes which **should be completed prior to the onsite portion of the course**, the course will include lecture, laboratories, an exam, videos, a final paper, and fieldtrips to (tentatively) Grand Canyon, Grand Canyon Caverns, SP Crater, Meteor Crater, Petrified Forest/Painted Desert, Museum of Northern Arizona, Out of Africa Wildlife Park, Lowell Observatory, and Lava River Cave.

- November 7th—Leave the housing facilities. The course bus will drive to the airport those students who are flying. [Ensure that the departure flight is after the bus arrival time. Bus schedule to be announced in the coming weeks.]
- December 1st—Tentative due date of Essay

Dual Enrollment Option

- Those choosing to take the course for college credit must also separately register and pay a fee to Freed-Hardeman University for the course, in **addition** to this registration (4 hours of college Physical Science credit). Contact Chris Gann for more information: cgann@fhu.edu. Note that you will need to s
- Classes for the Fall semester for Freed-Hardeman University officially begin August 19th, with the last day for registration being August 26th.
- Note that the college registration process can take a few days, so you will not want to wait until the week of August 19th to begin the college registration process.
- Dual enrollment students should keep track of the course deadlines through the FHU course site, keeping in mind that there are more requirements for taking the course for college credit (three extra papers and an extra exam for each chapter of the book).

E-mail is the primary means by which Dr. Miller will be contacting those attending the course.
